### *Process*

The athletic training staff (ATC) are available for basic first aid and referral recommendations for the Bangor High School Band & Color Guard. Below outlines details.

1. ATCs will evaluate in the athletic training room or on the field of the practice they are covering. They cannot leave sport coverage and interrupting during competition should be avoided when possible.
2. If the ATC determines the student should follow-up with a physician (orthopedic, family practice, urgent care, etc), in addition to informing the student, they will send an email to the band director with students name & referral recommendation.
  - a. In the case of a potential head injury they will also include the school nurse.
3. It will be the student's responsibility to communicate any follow-up information with band director.
  - a. The athletic trainers will not be providing clearance or, in the case of a head injury, overseeing the return to activity process.
